COMPETITIONS (EBA/EWBA RULES APPLY)

CHAMPIONSHIP SINGLES (MARKER REQUIRED)

Played with 4 woods each. Winner is first player to reach 21 shots.

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP SINGLES (MARKER REQUIRED)

Played with 4 woods each. Rules are as above except this Competition is NOT open to previous Winners of Championship Singles.

HANDICAP SINGLES (MARKER REQUIRED)

Played with 4 woods each. Each player's handicap will be added to their score on the first end. Winner is first player to 21.

TWO WOOD SINGLES (MARKER REQUIRED)

Only shots within 1 yard of the jack will count. This is measured using the yardstick (stored in the equipment store). 21 ends are played. All ends are counted even if neither player has scored. If scores are level after 21 ends an extra end will be played.

100-UP (MARKER REQUIRED)

Played with 4 woods each. The 4 woods nearest the jack will be scored as follows:

4 th WOOD	SCORES	1 POINT

The player scoring 100 points in 19 ends or less completed ends will be the winner. If the score is 100 points each at the end of the 20th end an extra end(s) will be played. <u>FOR ANY EXTRA ENDS THE MAT WILL BE A STANDARD 2 METRES FROM THE DITCH.</u> There is a special 100 UP scoreboard and 4321 scoreboard stored in the equipment store.

CHAMPIONSHIP PAIRS

Each player will play with 4 woods.

Winners are the pair with the highest score AFTER 18 ENDS. In the event of a draw after 18 ends an extra end will be played.

DRAWN PAIRS

Partners will be drawn.
